- •**The Legal Aid Society’s Cop Accountability Project Complaint Clinic** will support community members who were arrested and /or experienced police misconduct or brutality with hands–on legal advice and assistance with filing a Civilian Complaint Review Board Complaint, a Notice of Claim to sue the city, and much more information . A volunteer lawyer will guide you through the overall legal landscape .
